LISTED PROJECTS PUBLIC COMMENT

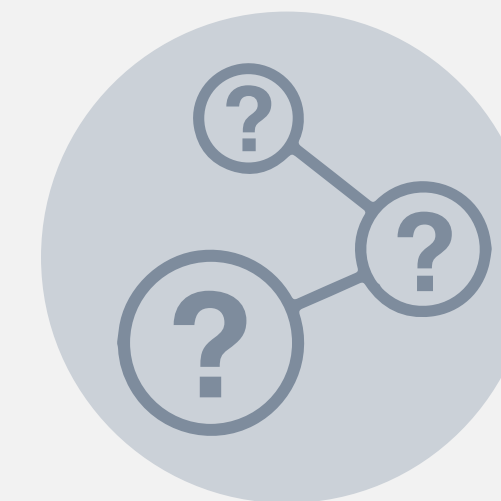
When projects meet initial screening requirements, they're listed publicly on our website for a 30-day public comment period. This is your chance to review and provide feedback before projects move forward.
