Job Description

The Analyst, Program Operations is responsible for providing substantive and logistical support to the project review processes under the organization's carbon crediting programs. Key duties include:

- Process administration and operation: Support the administration and operation of a growing number of emission reduction and removal projects using the Reserve's portfolio of protocols.
- **Project reviews**: Conduct first-level reviews of carbon project submittal and verification documentation.
- **Guidance**: Support the provision of technical and administrative guidance to account holders and other users.
- **Training**: Assist in the delivery and provision of protocol trainings to project developers and verifiers.

Skills and Qualifications

Essential:

- Substantive familiarity with carbon markets, greenhouse gas crediting, or forestry carbon accounting, gained through relevant work, co-curricular, and/or academic experiences.
- Undergraduate degree.
- Attention to detail.
- An ability to write clearly, concisely, and effectively.

- Legal right to work in the jurisdiction of residence.
- Fluency in English.

Preferable:

- Professional work experience.
- A graduate or professional degree.
- Competency in one or more official languages of the jurisdictions where the organization is active.

Working Conditions

This position requires significant daily overlap (at least 5 hours) with Pacific Time business hours. Although most duties may be performed virtually, occasional in-person presence is required (e.g., site visits, events, retreats).

Salary and Benefits
