### **Job Description**

The position of Regional Head (Asia), Market Development is responsible for advancing the Reserve's presence across the Asia-Pacific region. Key duties include:

- Strategic policy, government partnerships, and market integration: Lead engagement with governments and key market actors to position the Reserve within emerging compliance and voluntary frameworks (including Article 6, ICVCM, and CORSIA).
- Corporate climate policy and advocacy: Engage with corporate buyers in the region to advance the Reserve's role in supporting credible climate commitments and advocate for high-integrity credit use within decarbonization strategies.
- Regional leadership and stakeholder engagement: Serve as the Reserve's primary representative in Asia, fostering strategic partnerships with multilateral agencies, nongovernmental organizations, project developers, and verifiers to further the Reserve's presence and programmatic growth in the region.
- Identify and advance strategic opportunities: Assess and prioritize high-potential countries and sectors for protocol development, program expansion, and partnerships that drive measurable growth and impact.
- **Gain, analyze, and act on market intelligence:** Monitor policy, market, and investment trends to inform strategic decision-making, identify emerging risks and opportunities, and support the Reserve's market development strategy.

### Skills and Qualifications

#### Essential:

- At least 12 years of relevant professional work experience.
- Deep substantive knowledge of carbon markets and climate policy frameworks (including Article 6, ICVCM, and CORSIA).
- Experience building partnerships with governments, multilateral organizations, privatesector entities, and non-governmental organizations.
- Ability to analyze and interpret policy developments, market trends, and technical reports to inform decision-making and program strategy.
- Skilled at presenting complex technical or policy topics to varied audiences.
- Fluency in English.
- Legal right to work, and legal and physical residence, in a jurisdiction in Asia.

#### Preferable:

Fluency in one or more Asian languages.

### **Working Conditions**

This position is based in Asia. The ongoing legal right to work, and ongoing legal and physical residence, in a jurisdiction in Asia are conditions for holding this position. Although many duties of the position may be performed virtually, certain duties must be performed in person (e.g., events). This position requires occasional availability during Pacific Time business hours.
